

Incomplete Grade Contract

The grade I means that part of the regularly assigned work of the course remains undone and that course objectives have not been completed during the allotted course time due to circumstances usually beyond the student's control. An "I" grade shall be conferred only when there is a reasonable possibility that a passing grade will result when work is completed. **If not enough course work has been completed to determine if a passing grade is reasonable, an incomplete will NOT be granted. Grades already earned in the class will NOT be replaced if an I is granted.**

Note: You will not be allowed to enroll in any course in which this course is a prerequisite until all work has been completed and a final grade submitted.
